


**Nebraska's

What is ESAR-VHP?

- Electronic database of healthcare workers willing to volunteer during emergencies.
- System includes verifiable, up-to-date information regarding the volunteer's identity, license, professional credentials, and privileges in hospitals or other medical facilities.


Why Is The System Necessary?

The U.S. Department of Health and Human Services requires every state that receives a Hospital Preparedness Program grant to develop an ESAR-VHP Program.



Linking States

The ultimate goal of the ESAR-VHP program is to link states in order to create a national database of volunteers.
